Dear Mr. Gish:

On January 29, 2003, you filed on behalf of RockGen Energy, LLC ("RockGen") an Offer of Settlement in the above-referenced docket, which included a Settlement Agreement and Explanatory Statement pursuant to Rule 602 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. Initial comments in support of the Offer of Settlement were filed by Commission Trial Staff on February 11, 2003 and jointly by ATC and the Consensus Group on February 18, 2003. No reply comments were filed. On March 13, 2003, the Presiding Settlement Judge certified the Offer of Settlement to the Commission as uncontested.
2. The subject settlement is in the public interest and is hereby approved. In addition, the rate schedules submitted as part of the settlement are in compliance with Order No. 614 (FERC Statutes and regulations ¶ 31,096 (2001)) and are accepted for filing as designated. The Commission's acceptance of this settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding. The Commission retains the right to investigate the rates, terms and conditions under the just and reasonable and not unduly discriminatory or preferential standard of Section 206 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824e (1994).

3. This letter terminates Docket Nos. ER02-2314-000 and ER02-2314-001.
