ORDER APPROVING UNCONTESTED SETTLEMENT

(Issued July 9, 2004)

1. On May 14, 2004, Southern California Edison Company (SoCal Edison) filed a settlement agreement on behalf of itself and the City of Moreno Valley, California that reflects a comprehensive settlement of all issues in these dockets. Initial comments in support of the settlement were filed by Trial Staff on May 26, 2004. No reply comments were filed. The Presiding Administrative Law Judge certified the Settlement on June 14, 2004.
2. The subject settlement is in the public interest and is hereby approved. The Commission's approval of this settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding. The Commission retains the right to investigate the rates, terms, and conditions under the just and reasonable and not unduly discriminatory or preferential standard of section 206 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824e (2000).
3. The tariff sheets submitted with the referenced Settlement are not in compliance with Order No. 614. Designation of Electric Rate Schedule Sheets, Order No. 614, FERC Stats. & Regs. ¶ 31,096 (2000). SoCal Edison is hereby directed to file within 30 days the revised pages of the four Interconnection Facilities Agreements so that they are entitled "FERC Electric Tariff First Revised Volume No. 5."

4. This order terminates Docket Nos. ER04-383-000, ER04-384-000, ER04-384-001, ER04-385-000, and ER04-386-000. New subdockets will be assigned upon receipt of the required compliance filing.
