Ladies and Gentlemen:

1. On May 30, 2003, Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company (Tennessee) filed a request for waiver of Article XXV of the General Terms and Conditions of its tariff to omit the filing of revised tariff sheets with its required semi-annual take-or-pay report because it has not incurred significant take-or-pay costs since the effectiveness of its last recovery filing in Docket No. RP03-143-000. For good cause shown, Tennessee's request for waiver is granted, and Tennessee's report showing the derivation of the balances in its take-or pay transition volumetric account and demand account is accepted.

2. Notice of the filing was issued June 5, 2003, with comments due June 12, 2003. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.
