



2. On January 17, 2001, in Docket No. RT01-75-001, Entergy filed the workpapers relevant to its RTO proposal. Numerous parties filed motions to intervene.
3. On July 12, 2001, in Docket Nos. RT01-34-000, RT01-34-002, RT01-75-000, and RT01-75-003, the Commission issued an order rejecting the RTO filings.<sup>2</sup> Numerous parties sought rehearing in Docket Nos. RT01-34-004 and RT01-75-005.
4. On July 12, 2001, in Docket Nos. RT01-74-002 and RT01-74-003, the Commission issued an order on compliance filing and status report.<sup>3</sup> Numerous parties sought rehearing in Docket No. RT01-74-005.
5. On July 12, 2001, in Docket No. RT01-100-000, the Commission directed the parties in Docket Nos. RT01-34-000, RT01-74-000, RT01-75-000, and RT01-77-000 to participate in mediation for the purpose of facilitating the formation of a single Regional Transmission Organization for the Southeastern United States.<sup>4</sup> The attempt at mediation was unsuccessful. Numerous parties sought rehearing in Docket Nos. RT01-100-001 and RT01-77-002.
6. It is now apparent that the matters at issue in these proceedings have been overtaken by superceding events. Accordingly, we will terminate the instant proceedings.

The Commission orders:

These proceedings are hereby terminated.
