ORDER DISMISSING REQUEST FOR REHEARING AS MOOT

(Issued February 20, 2014)

1. On June 20, 2013, the Commission conditionally accepted a filing by Entergy Services, Inc. on behalf of the Entergy Operating Companies¹ (collectively, Entergy) to cancel Service Schedule MSS-2 of the Entergy System Agreement upon transfer of the transmission assets of Entergy Corporation and certain of its subsidiaries to ITC Midsouth, a newly-created subsidiary of ITC Holdings Corp. (ITC Holdings) and certain of its subsidiaries (the Entergy-ITC Transaction).² In the Notice of Cancellation Order, the Commission accepted the notice of cancellation subject to, and with an effective date of, the closing of the Entergy-ITC Transaction. On July 22, 2013, the Louisiana Public Service Commission filed a request for rehearing of the Notice of Cancellation Order.

2. On December 13, 2013, ITC Holdings and Entergy filed a Notice of Termination of Transaction in Docket No. EC12-145-000, notifying the Commission that the Entergy-ITC Transaction would not occur. In its original notice of cancellation for Service Schedule MSS-2, Entergy had stated that if the Entergy-ITC Transaction did not close, it would not cancel Service Schedule MSS-2. Therefore, the Commission accepted the

notice of cancellation subject to the closing of the Entergy-ITC Transaction. The Notice of Cancellation Order has been rendered moot by the cancellation of the Entergy-ITC Transaction and Service Schedule MSS-2 remains a valid service schedule on file with the Commission. Accordingly, the request for rehearing is dismissed as moot.

The Commission orders:

The request for rehearing is hereby dismissed as moot, as discussed in the body of this order.
