Dear Mr. Driver:

1. On February 24, 2014, you filed, on behalf of Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company (OG&E) and Arkansas Electric Cooperative Corporation (AECC), a Joint Uncontested Offer of Settlement (Settlement Agreement). The Settlement Agreement resolves all issues surrounding a complaint filed by AECC against OG&E challenging certain rate components of the bilateral cost-based formula rate agreement for requirements electric service by and between OG&E and AECC (Formula Agreement). No comments were filed on the Settlement Agreement.
2. The Settlement Agreement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest and is hereby approved, effective March 1, 2014, per the terms of article VII, section 1 of the Settlement Agreement. The Commission's approval of the Settlement Agreement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding.
3. OG&E states it has not filed the Settlement Agreement in eTariff format. Within 30 days of the date of this order, OG&E is required to submit a compliance filing through

eTariff to ensure that the electronic tariff data base reflects the Commission's action in this proceeding.¹

4. This letter order terminates Docket No. EL14-13-000.
