NOTICE OF INTENT NOT TO ACT

(April 21, 2016)

1. On February 5, 2014, Occidental Chemical Corporation (Occidental) filed a petition requesting that the Commission initiate an enforcement action pursuant to section 210(h)(2) of the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978 (PURPA)<sup>1</sup> against the Louisiana Public Service Commission (Louisiana Commission). On April 4, 2014, the Commission issued a notice of intent not to act at this time,<sup>2</sup> and gave notice that it reserved “its ability to issue a further order or to take further action at a future date should the Commission find that doing so is appropriate.”
2. Notice is hereby given that the Commission declines to initiate an enforcement action under section 210(h)(2) of PURPA.<sup>3</sup>
